

David McKee - assistant director

David McKee was educated at Oakham School, Rutland where he held a music scholarship. After School, he spent a year in **Truro**, where he was a choral scholar in the Cathedral Choir. He also taught singing at Richard Lander School, and worked alongside the director of music there as the assistant director of Cornwall youth Chamber Choir.

In September 2000, David moved to Exeter, where he studied music at both undergraduate and postgraduate level. During this time he was busy as both a singer and a conductor in and around Exeter. He was a full time member of Exeter Cathedral Choir, and directed the Exeter University Singers and the Wesley Singers. He also enjoyed numerous engagements as both a soloist and an ensemble singer throughout the South West of England.

After a period spent working for the Royal School of Church Music in Surrey, which he combined with singing as a member of the top professional choir of St. Peter's, Eaton Square, London, David spent a year teaching in the music department at the Brighton and Hove High School for Girls. In September 2006, David moved to Norwich to take up the position of Director of Music at the Notre Dame High School, combining this with the position of bass lay-clerk at Norwich Cathedral.
